

Fascinating Fossils Workshop



Key Stage 2 90-minute facilitated session

In this cross-curricular workshop, your pupils will have a unique experience of seeing Dippy the Dinosaur, currently on loan from the Natural History Museum, uncovering key facts about the nation's favourite dinosaur with the Herbert's Learning Team. Pupils will also get to handle real fossils from the Herbert's collection, exploring how fossils are formed and why they are so important. Pupils will then embark on cross-curricular learning as they produce their own fossil inspired print to take back to school, helping them to uncover the finer details of our natural history collection in a creative way.

Your pupils will:

- Use discussion and role play in order to learn.
- Listen and respond appropriately to adults and their peers.
- Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock.
- Produce creative work, exploring their ideas and recording their experiences.
