

Patterns & Prints - Picasso: Linocuts from the British Museum

Key Stages 1, 2 and 3 90 minute facilitated session (available 11 Sept 2017 – 1 Dec 2017)

The exhibition of Picasso's prints is an ideal way for children to discover pattern and learn about printmaking techniques. Pupils will discover why Picasso is viewed as one of the most important and influential artists of the 20th Century. Drawing inspiration from the amazing artworks on display, pupils can design and create their own prints to take away.

This workshop involves messy materials and aprons, and accompanying adults will be expected to assist.

- Know about great artists, and understand the historical and cultural development of their art forms
- Use discussion in order to learn
- Become proficient in simple printmaking techniques
