

Getting to Herbert Art Gallery & Museum

Open: Tuesday to Saturday from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM and Sunday from 12:00 PM to 4:00 PM

Herbert Art Gallery & Museum is located at Jordan Well, Coventry CV1 5QP, right next to Coventry Cathedral.

By foot: from Coventry railway station, it is a 10 to 15-minute walk through the city centre, or you can catch a direct bus from Rail Station Bridge taking about 3 minutes. Taxis are also available at the station.

By bus: all city centre buses stop nearby; it is a 5-minute walk from Pool Meadow bus station or 10 minutes from other central stops.

By car: the address is Jordan Well, CV1 5QP. Limited parking is available in the city centre.

Getting to the Delia Derbyshire Building, Coventry University

Open: 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM, Monday to Saturday.

Delia Derbyshire Building is located on Cox Street, CV1 5PH at Coventry University, directly opposite Starley Gardens.

By foot: the building sits on Cox Street, integrated into the eastern side of the Coventry University campus near the Elephant Building. It is easily accessed on foot from the main university precinct or central Coventry.

By bus: there are bus stops directly outside the building on Cox Street. Several local bus routes serve this stop, including the 12X Platinum, 24, 25A, 24A, 25, 25X, and 735.

By car: the address is Cox Street, Coventry, CV1 5PH. Limited parking is available in the city centre.

Getting to the Mead Gallery, Warwick Arts Centre

Open: Tuesday to Sunday from 11:00 AM to 8:00 PM (closed on Mondays)

* Please note that during the winter holidays from Mon 14 Dec to Mon 11 Jan, the exhibition will only be open 10am – 4pm on Tuesdays, Saturdays and Sundays.

The Mead Gallery is located inside the Warwick Arts Centre at the University of Warwick main campus, CV4 7FD.

By bus: take the 12X from outside Coventry train station, 11, or 11U bus directly to the University of Warwick central campus bus interchange. The arts centre is a very short, 100-metre walk from the bus stops.

By car: the campus is easily reached via the A45, A46, and M40. Limited parking is available on the university campus.

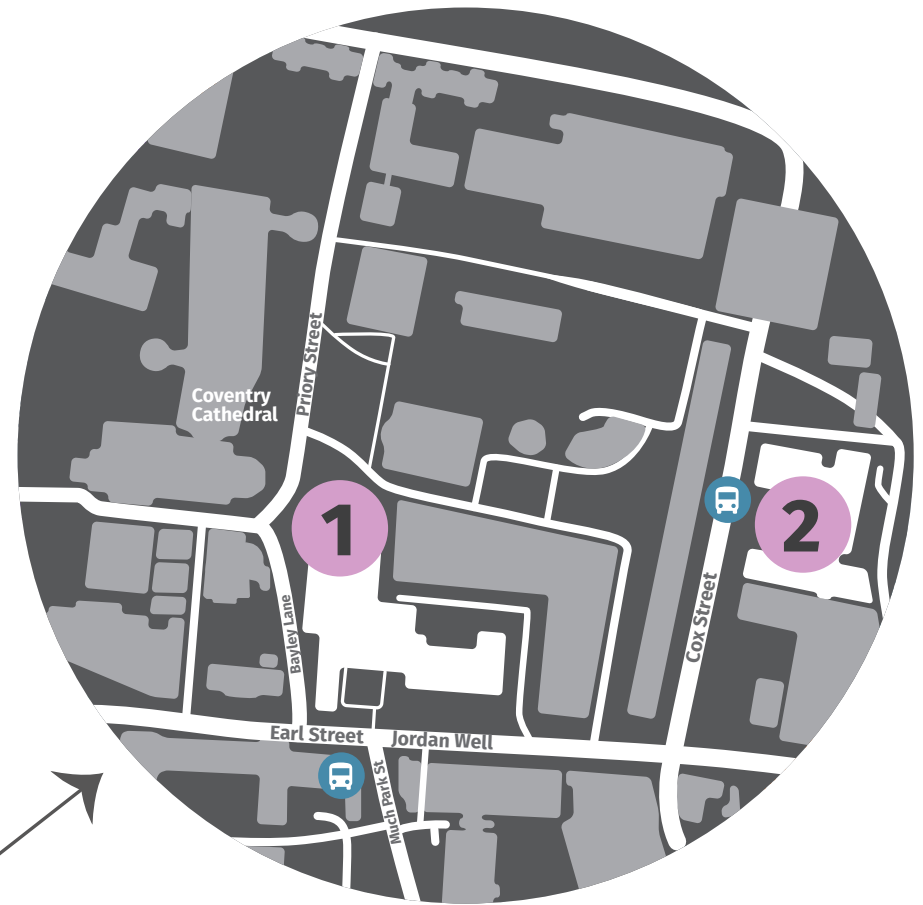
